



Essential Spring Cleaning

When spring arrives, it is time to do those things that could not be done in the cold and snowy season. Below are several tasks you may want to schedule to whip your facility back into shape:

1. Windows - now that it is warm enough to get outside, give those panes a cleaning so that staff and patrons can enjoy the spring view.
2. High Dusting - with people trapped inside and less fresh air flow during the cold months, dust has had a chance to find all kinds of nooks and crannies to hide in. In particular, give those high places that get missed a once over.
3. Entrance Matting - Mats will need to be extracted to clean up after the slush and dirt that was dragged in.
4. Interim Floor Touch-up - The winter season wreaks havoc on floor finish. Pull out the Deep Scrub and give your floors a touch-up.
5. Custodial Room Spring-clean - Take the time to tidy up the janitor's closet. Get rid of old items, and items that are not being used.



Washroom Odour

Have you ever wondered why a washroom sometimes still has an unpleasant odour after it has been cleaned? It is because the source of that odour is probably being missed in the clean up.

Daily washroom cleaning tends to focus on the primary surfaces: the counters and taps, the door handles, and of course the urinals and toilets. But that is not necessarily where washroom odours are hiding. The tile, or more specifically, the grout between the tiles that surround urinals and toilets, will absorb the substances that produce foul odours once bacteria enters the equation.

To prevent these odours, there are daily, interim, and restorative level cleaning steps you can employ to keep washroom odours under control:

Daily: When wiping down toilets and urinals after the disinfection step, make sure that you spray the floor around and under these fixtures with a bio-enzymatic odor digester such as AIRX 65. Do not wipe it up, but rather, let it air dry. This will seep into the grout and kill off odour causing bacteria. It will also change the shape of existing malodours so that it is no longer registered by our sense of smell as foul.

Interim: About once a week, rather than just damp mopping the floors (wringing out the mop), wet mop the area. To wet mop, lightly tamp the mop in the wringer, but do not use the wringer. Make sure you are using a disinfectant floor cleaner, such as AIRX 15. Allow the solution to sit on the floor for 10 minutes, then damp mop the solution off.

Restorative: Give the floors a really good scrub with an automatic scrubber. This will get into the grout between the tiles where the issue resides. The Nilfisk-Advance SC350 small sized scrubber (spotlighted on the reverse side of this page) is ideal for the task, since it can get into the tight places around toilets and urinals.
